“Hands on History” Field Trip to Angkor Wat



Many children who live within immediate proximity of the temples have not had the opportunity to visit them and are not yet aware of the richness of their own culture and heritage. Not only that, many rural children have never been to the city of Siem Reap and many of today's experiences will be "firsts" for them.

You will accompany 20 school students, their teacher, and one licensed tour guide (giving the tour in Khmer) on a tour to Angkor Wat Temple with a lunch stop in Siem Reap City.

**Itinerary:**

**DEPART: Between 7-8 am, depending on the school.**

**RETURN: 4.00pm. To Siem Reap**

Experience the wonder of Angkor Wat & Bayon Temples, along with a group of 20 excited children. Join the students for lunch and enjoy the novelty of the experience for them as they eat in a Siem Reap restaurant. Visit Lucky Mall where they will see amazing things like sliding glass doors and ride escalators for the first time, get an ice-cream, as well as visiting a bookstore and choosing a book to take home. Every field trip will be slightly different to the next as no two groups are the same!

# HELPFUL TIPS

## AT THE TEMPLES:

- Cambodians are conservative and dress modestly. We ask that you dress modestly as well. Shorts are acceptable but should be knee-length and shoulders must be covered. Mini skirts, tank tops and low-cut tops are not acceptable attire in the countryside.
- Please do not buy anything or give money to children on the street or temples. Many children are rented out by their parents for a pittance and are controlled by an overseer. We encourage you not to support or sustain child labor and exploitation.
- Temples are sacred sites in Cambodia. Visitors are expected to behave respectfully during your visit. This means that you should keep noise to a minimum, don't touch the carvings and respect prohibited areas.



## AT PLF LOCATIONS:

- During your Help for a Day experience you will be considered a member of the PLF team; please be respectful to the Khmer teachers and set a good example for the students at all times.
- Please be punctual.
- We ask you not to smoke around students.
- PLF can provide tax receipts for participants from the USA, Canada and the UK.
